

## THEME NIGHT INFORMATION

- SEPT 13th ... "Ice Cream" Night** - All clubbers and leaders will cool down with some ice cream on this night.
- SEPT 27th ... "Get Wet" Night** - Be prepared to do some crazy water games during game time, as we meet out in the front yard for activity!
- OCT 4th ... "Flashlight & Missions" Night** - Turn off the lights. All clubbers and leaders receive a glow-in-the dark bracelet when they arrive. Have them bring flashlights. Play relay games with flashlights. Challenge children to be a light in a dark world. Unveil our Adopt-a-Club fundraising plans for the year (coins due back November 1st).
- OCT 11th ... "Wear Your Team Color" Night** - To create team spirit, wear your color that your team has been assigned during game time.
- OCT 18th ... "School Spirit" Night** - This is the night to be proud of the school you attend. Wear a shirt, hat or anything else to let us know!
- OCT 25th ... "Bible Heroes" Night** - Clubber dress up as their favorite Bible hero, or they may dress up to represent a Bible story or concept.
- NOV 1st ... "Adopt-a-Club" Night** - See the opportunity to Adopt-a-Club during Council time. Hear about an Awana club oversees. Clubbers and leaders will be challenged to adopt an Awana Club (bring their coins).
- NOV 8th ... "Shoebox" Night** - Collect items to make shoe boxes for Samaritan's Purse. Games played with shoeboxes!
- NOV 15th ... "Can Food Line Up" Night** - Clubbers bring cans of food. Line them up on their game line. See which color line makes the longest line. The food will be taken to the *Second Harvest Food Bank* by our older children in December.
- NOV 29th ... "Silent" Night** - No one is allowed to talk except possibly during handbook time (or maybe older kids can write down their conversations w leaders?). Make up posters with games on them so the clubbers can read what games will be played. Clubbers act like they are clapping but their hands do not touch.
- JAN 3rd ... "Super Section" Night** - This is the night clubbers are encouraged to say as many sections as they can! There is no limit, as we hope to challenge clubbers to "load up" and learn over the month of December, even though we will break for Awana. We will give special and "SUPER" recognition to those individuals and groups who say the most sections!!
- JAN 10th ... "Wacky Tacky" Night** - How wacky and how tacky can you look?? Mismatched clothes ... shoes on wrong feet or even different shoes ... go ahead, embarrass your family, just do it in good taste. We'll all enjoy the laugh!!
- JAN 17th ... "Create a Theme" Night** - Write out and submit your own idea for an *Awana* Theme night we've never had before. We just might select yours for our Mystery Theme Night on March 21st!!
- JAN 24th ... "Pajama" Night** - Clubbers are encouraged to come ready for bed, wearing their pajamas. Teddy bears, anyone??
- JAN 31st ... "AWANA GRAND PRIX"** - This exciting race for all clubbers, leaders and ANYONE is now on Sunday night! Get your kit and get your car built for this exciting race night. With some cool competition and an exciting devotion, this night is sure to be a blast!!
- FEB 7th ... "When I Grow Up" Night** - Clubbers are encouraged to dress as they wish to be one day! We will probably have firemen, nurses, doctors, pastors, and hey, maybe even an Awana leader or two!!
- FEB 14th ... "Favorite Hat" Night** - All clubbers and leaders are encouraged to wear their favorite hat. We'll even play games with hats!
